

The Horse-riding Raid of Ademuz celebrates its most international edition

During the weekend of November 10th and 11th, Ademuz will become the international equestrian capital with its Equestrian Raid, which includes the celebration of the Copa del Rey and the International Equestrian Championship.



The **Horse Raid of Ademuz** continues to consolidate year after year in the international equestrian scene. On November 10th and 11th, Ademuz and its privileged surroundings will welcome horses and riders from different countries. The route through forest tracks and agricultural roads of the municipality on good grounds makes of this municipality the perfect place for this competition.

On Saturday, the main events that will be held in this raid are the III International Equestrian Championship of the Rincón de Ademuz, the Copa de SM El Rey, the Copa Âl-Dâmus for Women, the Military Open and the National Championship. The distances will be between 80 and 120 km and departures will take place between 8:30 and 9:00 am. On Sunday, there will be the Regional and Beginners championships, with distances from 10 to 80 kms, and the delivery of prizes to the winners.

In parallel to the equestrian events, there will be many activities. There will be guided tours that will allow you to discover everything that **Ademuz** has to offer on a natural, cultural and ethnological level. Children who come to the raid will also have their corner, with children's workshops that will keep them entertained during the contest.

And you cannot miss a market with the best handicrafts and local products and meals organized in the restaurants of the town to taste the local cuisine. All the ingredients to spend a wonderful weekend.
