Weather in the Valencia Region, forecasts and information in real time

Here you can check real time and online all the information generated by the 17 weather stations located at strategic points of our magnificent geography. This way, wherever you are, you can access information on the weather in the Valencia Region. Keep up with the evolution of the weather forecast for the next days in 150 geographic points: 125 municipalities, 21 golf courses and four maritime areas. If you're traveling to the Mediterranean coast, you should know that the weather is not the same in all regions. The weather in the Valencia Region is mainly based in the Mediterranean climate, but according to the area you are visiting, you will find slightly different nuances. If you decide to visit the province of Valencia (Gandia, Torrent, Sagunto...), you should know that the typical Mediterranean climate prevails. So the winters are mild and summers are usually long, somewhat dry and hot. In some cities in the province of Alicante, such as Villena, Alcoy, Elda and Játiva, time is governed by colder winters and much hotter summers. In the Costa Blanca area (Alicante, Benidorm, Elche, Orihuela,

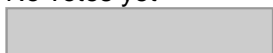
Torreveija and other coastal towns in the province of Alicante) temperatures are fairly mild in winter and are very warm during summer time. On the other hand, higher mountain areas of Valencia sometimes feature rainfall in winter. But it is worth it when low temperatures turn them into snowflakes, covering the beautiful landscapes of white during winter. This is the easiest way of checking the weather in the Valencia Region and enjoying your vacation.
