The building, originally, was a convent with a college that later became a University. The south facade has a marked horizontal appearance, and presents three access doors, to the church, to the conv...

- Convent of the Agustinas [14]

The Convent possesses not only the church, but also a cloister dating back to the XVII century. However, the closed nature of the Convent only allows religious people to visit the temple.

The temple reflects the austerity of the Franciscans. With the disentanglement of Mendizábal it ceased to exercise its function and the cloister was used for social ends.

Mesolithic archaeological materials were found in this cavity of over 90 metres deep and 15 of unevenness. Despite the scarcity of remains found, a piece of handmade ceramics decorated with red zigzag...

In this cave Prehistoric remains have been found pertaining to the Palaeolithic period, giving rise to the speculation of the human occupation of the area.
