Almassora, which takes its name from the Latin "mansio" (meaning an inn or stopping place), is in the area of Plana Alta in the province of [Castellón](#) ^[1], on the banks of the River Millars, boasting a privileged location. **This coastal town** offers many attractions: a peaceful beach away from the crowds, and a whole host of services; the mouth of the River Millars, declared a Protected Landscape due to its ecological importance; a stroll around the old town or "Vila" reveals the roots of **Almassora**, with buildings of great historic and architectural interest; finally, in the area surrounding the town, also on the banks of the river, we find the Hermitage of Santa Quiteria, situated in an area of great [natural beauty](#) ^[2], where we can enjoy other interesting features such as the dam and the medieval bridge.
