

Rural Tourism in the Region of Valencia



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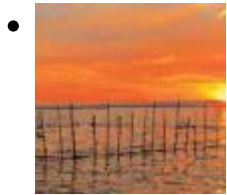

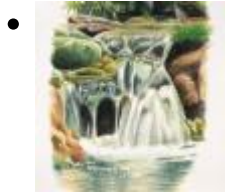


La Tinença de Benifassà ^[15]

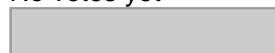
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
